

# Installation Instructions TrekStep Side–Mount™






# 2 Assemble Cross Bar Bracket

Thread an M10-1.5 Hex Nut about two thirds of the way onto the M10-1.5 x 30mm Hex Head Screw. Insert the screw into the slot in the Cross Bar Bracket and thread another M10-1.5 Hex Nut on to the screw. Leave loose for later adjustment.






4 Install Front Mounting Bracket

Locate the flange with one (1) hole that points down in front of the Rear Mounting Bracket. Set the Front Mounting Bracket on top of the Rear Mounting Bracket and line up the hole in the bracket with the hole in the front side of the flange.

Put a drop of Loctite on the threads of the M6-1.0 x 22mm Hex Head Screw. Use it to install the Front Mounting Bracket to the flange with the M6 Flat Washer and M6-1.0 Nylock Nut.


Leave the fasteners loose.



M6-1.0 x 22mm Hex Head




Put a drop of Loctite on the threads of two (2) M10-1.5 x 45mm Hex Head Screws. Thread the screws with M10 Split Lock Washers through both brackets and into the Linkage. Tighten the bolts securely. Fully tighten the fasteners installed in Steps 1 and 3.




# 6 Secure Cross Bar

Adjust the Inboard nut on the M10 X 30mm Hex Head Screw on the Cross Bar Bracket until the head of the screw is tight against the frame. Put a drop of Loctite on the threads of the screw and tighten the outboard nut tight against the bracket.



# 7 Install Step

Use the M6-1.0 x 20 Socket Head Cap Screws to mount the Step to the Linkage Assembly.




## 8 Step Adjustment

Once the Step is installed on the vehicle, you may adjust it as desired.

If necessary to adjust the height, use the two (2) 1/4" Spacers provided. Remove the M10-15 x 45mm Hex Bolts installed in Step 4 and place the 1/4" Spacers between the Frame Mount and the Linkage. Reinstall the Hex Bolts.

When the Step is in the desired position tighten all nuts.



#### **Operation**

- The TrekStep<sup>™</sup> is foot operated and deploys and retracts with a nudge of your foot.
- To deploy, press down using your foot, on the forward outside corner of the step pad.
- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
- Max Load Capacity: 400 lbs.
- Always use appropriate hand holds when stepping up to or down from your truck's cargo bed.

#### **Maintenance Tips**

The step pad surface and linkage arms can be washed with mild soap and water using a soft brush or sponge to dislodge any mud, dirt or accumulated road grime. Rinse with fresh water.

To prevent slipping, avoid applying waxes, lubricants or protectants like Armor All® to the step surface.
